1. Introduction

- 1.1 Our website uses cookies.
- 1.2 Insofar as those cookies are not strictly necessary for the provision of <https://www.bedrockdigitalops.com> and its Services, we will ask you to consent to our use of cookies when you first visit our website.

3. About cookies

- 3.1 A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and is stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.
- 3.2 Cookies may be either "persistent" cookies or "session" cookies: a persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until a set expiration date unless deleted by the user before the expiration date. A session cookie will expire at the end of each user session when the web browser is closed.
- 3.3 Cookies may not contain any information that personally identifies a user. However, personal data that we store about you may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.

4. Cookies that we use

- 4.1 We use cookies for the following purposes:
 - (a) **Authentication and status** - We use cookies to identify you when you visit our website and as you navigate our website.
 - (b) **Personalization** - We use cookies to store information about your preferences and to personalize our website for you
 - (c) **Analysis** - We use cookies to help us analyze the use and performance of our website and services
 - (d) **Cookie consent** - We use cookies to store your preferences concerning the use of cookies more generally.

5. Cookies used by our service providers

- 5.1 Our service providers use cookies which may be stored on your computer when you visit our website.
- 5.2 We use Google Analytics. Google Analytics gathers information about the use of our website by means of cookies. The information gathered is used to create reports about the use of our website. - 5.3 We use a Facebook pixel on our website. The Facebook pixel collects information about the users and use of our website. The information is used to personalize Facebook advertisements and to analyze the use of our website.
